





② Objectives

- Provide opportunity for NSB networking
- Demonstrate to members the value of ISO's international character and inform them about:
 - how standards support the SDGs
 - how standards support public policy
 - how to engage with policy-makers
 - how standards facilitate trade
- Raise awareness about ISO among UN agencies IOs and missions
- Strengthen the link between members and ISO/CS
