Modular Coordination-Coordinating Size of Opening A 0016-1979 for built-in Appliances (Reaffirmed: 1983) in Storage Furniture

1. Scope

This Japanese Industrial Standard specifies sizes of storage opening for built-in appliances in the inter-units, hereinafter referred to as the "units", for dwellings.

Remark: The storage inter-units mentioned in this standard are those specified in JIS A 4414 and JIS A 4415.

2. Reference Planes of Component and Storage Opening

2.1 Reference Planes of Component and Sub Reference Planes The units shall be provided with reference planes of component and sub reference planes which indicate the storage openings for appliances. In addition, sizes of storage opening in the units shall be given by the distances between the sub reference planes.

Furthermore, the position of the sub reference plane shall be indicated by the distance from the reference plane of component of the unit (see Fig. 1).
