Plain bearings—Symbols— Part 2: Applications

Introduction This Japanese Industrial Standard has been prepared based on the first edition of **ISO 7904-2:1995** *Plain bearings—Symbols—Part 2: Applications* published in 1995 with some modifications of the technical contents.

The portions underlined with dots in this Standard are the matters in which the contents of the original International Standard have been modified. A list of modifications with explanations is given in Annex (informative).

1 Scope This part of **JIS B 0163** specifies practical applications of the general symbols laid down in **JIS B 0163-1** with regard to the calculations, design and testing of plain bearings.

NOTE : The International Standard corresponding to this part of **JIS B 0163** is as follows:

In addition, symbols which denote the degree of correspondence in the contents between **JIS** and the relevant International Standard are **IDT** (identical), **MOD** (modified) and **NEQ** (not equivalent) according to **ISO/IEC Guide 21**.
