Glossary of Terms Relating to Equipments
of AutomobilesD 0110-1988
(Reaffirmed: 1993)1. Scope

This Japanese Industrial Standard specifies terms relating to equipment for automobiles (excluding motorcycles). However, terms relating to seats, ventilators and air conditioners are excluded.

2. Classification

The terms are classified according to the following purposes:

- (1) General
- (2) Exterior equipment
- (3) Interior equipment
- (4) Common equipment

3. Terms and Their Meaning

The terms and their meaning are as prescribed below.

Further, the correspondent foreign terms and customary terms are shown as informative reference.

- Remarks
1. In the column of terms, the letter in () following to the KANA letter is the KANJI letter not for ordinary use and is not a part of the term.
 2. The [] as a part of a term means that the letter(s) in [] is (are) generally omitted.
 3. In the column of meaning, the number in () following to a term means the term number in this Standard.
 4. The term marked with "reference" in the column of number means that the term and its meaning of cited Standard are transferred as they are.
 5. The customary terms will not be used in future.
