- 2. <u>Definitions</u> For the purpose of this Standard the definitions in JIS D 0103 as well as the following definitions apply:
- (1) <u>high mount stop lamp</u> The stop lamp equipped at the relatively higher position on a central part of rear surface of automobile.
- (2) <u>vehicle median plane</u> The longitudinal median plane of the class of vehicle equipped with lighting and light signalling devices, specified in JIS D 0102 or JIS D 0109.
- (3) <u>applicable class of vehicle</u> In the case where the class of vehicle equipped with the lighting and light signalling devices are identified, the name and type of that automobile or its popular name.
