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Foreword

Introduction

This Japanese Industrial Standard has been prepared based on **ISO 4957** : 2018, Edition 3, with some modifications of the technical contents.

Annex JA is unique to **JIS** and not given in the corresponding International Standard. The vertical lines on both sides and dotted underlines indicate changes from the corresponding International Standard. A list of modifications with the explanations is given in Annex JB.

1 Scope

This Standard specifies the requirements for carbon tool steels (hereafter referred to as tool steels) mainly manufactured by hot-rolling or hot-forging.

NOTE The International Standard corresponding to this Standard and the symbol of degree of correspondence are as follows.
