#### 1. Scope

This Japanese Industrial Standard specifies the iron (III) oxide for ferrite.

Remark: The units and numerical values given in { } in this standard are in accordance with the International System of Units (SI), and are appended for reference.

#### 2. Classification

The iron (III) oxide for ferrite shall be classified into the following three classes according to the contents of main components and other components.

- (1) Class 1
- (2) Class 2
- (3) Class 3

#### 3. Quality

The iron (III) oxide for ferrite shall be tested in accordance with 5. and shall conform to the requirements given in following Table.
