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Foreword

This Japanese Industrial Standard has been revised by the Minister of Economy, Trade and Industry through deliberations at the Japanese Industrial Standards Committee as the result of proposal for revision of Japanese Industrial Standard submitted by Japan Reagent Association (JRA)/Japanese Standards Association (JSA) with a draft being attached, based on the provision of Article 12, paragraph (1) of the Industrial Standardization Act applied mutatis mutandis pursuant to the provision of Article 16 of the said Act. This edition replaces the previous edition (JIS K 8355: 2006), which has been technically revised.

1 Scope

This Standard specifies the requirements for acetic acid intended for use as a reagent.

- WARNING 1 Acetic acid is a harmful substance. Inhalation of its vapour and adherence to mucous membrane and skin should be avoided. This is flammable and should be kept away from fire.
- WARNING 2 Persons carrying out tests based on this Standard should be familiar with normal laboratory practice. This Standard does not purport to address all of the safety problems, if any, associated with its use. It is the responsibility of the user of this Standard to establish appropriate safety and health practices, by reference to SDS (safety data sheets), etc.
- NOTE The International Standard corresponding to this Standard and the symbol of degree of correspondence are as follows.
