Textiles — Care labelling code using symbols

Introduction

This Japanese Industrial Standard has been prepared based on **ISO 3758** : 2023, Edition 4, with some modifications of the technical contents. It is established to correspond to the globalization of production and distribution of textile articles, and to the textile care process actually applied in some of the domestic washings, and dry cleanings and wet cleanings in professional textile care in Japan.

The dotted underlines indicate changes from the corresponding International Standard. A list of modifications with the explanations is given in Annex JA.

1 Scope

This standard is intended for use in the markings of textile articles and to provide information on the most severe treatment, such as washing, of such articles that will not cause irreversible damage to the product. It specifies a system of graphic symbols (hereafter referred to as symbols) and the markings thereof related to the textile care process in domestic washing (washing, bleaching, drying and ironing) and professional textile care (dry cleaning and wet cleaning). It is not applicable to industrial laundering.

The information for household laundering marked by symbols can also be useful for dry cleaners.

The following are examples of textile articles that are not subject to this Standard:

- non-removable covers of upholstered furniture;
- non-removable covers of mattresses;
- carpets and rugs which require professional carpet cleaning.

These products are excluded due to specific cleaning processes not specified in this Standard.

NOTE 1 Symbols and markings for industrial laundering, such as those for linen supply or work clothes, can be found in **ISO 30023**.

NOTE 2 The International Standard corresponding to this Standard and the symbol of degree of correspondence are as follows.

ISO 3758 : 2023 *Textiles — Care labelling code using symbols* (MOD)

In addition, symbols which denote the degree of correspondence in the contents between the relevant International Standard and **JIS** are IDT (identical), MOD (modified), and NEQ (not equivalent) according to **ISO/IEC Guide 21-1**.
