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Glossary of terms used in body measurements for clothes

1 Scope This Japanese Industrial Standard specifies main terms used in the body measurements for clothes.

NOTE : The body measurement shall be carried out as follows as a rule. The person to be measured shall stand upright keeping the head such that the ear-eye plane is horizontal, with both arms hanging freely, knees stretched, and toes slightly opened. If the person to be measured is physically unable to stand upright, he or she shall lie on the back keeping the head such that the ear-eye plane is vertical, with both arms stretched in a spontaneous way, palms slightly touching the sides, and other parts of the body postured in a way that they would be in standing.

2 Classification The terms shall be classified follows:

- a) Terms related to the standard parts of the body
- b) Terms related to the size of the body

3 Terms and definitions The terms and definitions shall be as follows (see attached figures 1 to 6).

NOTE : English equivalents are given for reference.
