(Reaffirmed: 1984)1. Scope

This Japanese Industrial Standard specifies stitch symbols to be used in knitting with industrial knitting machines (excluding hand knitting and hand knitting machines) and design paper used for entering the knitting symbols and knitting stitches.

2. Definitions

For the purposes of this Standard, the following definitions apply:

- (1) stitch symbol A symbol used to represent a knitting stitch using design paper.
- (2) knitting symbol A symbol used to represent the sequence of knitting with a latch needle using design paper.
