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Glossary of terms used in textile industry (Dyeing and finishing)

1 Scope This Japanese Industrial Standard specifies the main terms to be used for the technical terms of dyeing and finishing in the textile industry.

2 Normative references The following standards contain provisions which, through reference in this Standard, constitute provisions of this Standard. The most recent editions of the standards (including amendments) indicated below shall be applied.

3 Classification The terms used in textile industry (dyeing and finishing) shall be classified into the following nine classes. The number of four places including these classes shall be the heading number of the terms.

- a) General
- b) Preprocess
- c) Dyeing
- d) Printing
- e) Postprocess
- f) Functional finishing
- g) Dyestuff and agents
- h) Colour fastness
- i) Environment

4 Numbers, terms and definitions The numbers, terms and definitions shall be as follows.

Remarks : When two or more terms are mentioned together in the one column of term, it shall be preferentially used according to the order of mention.
