2. Symbols

2.1 Classification Symbols shall be classified into the following 6 categories:

- (1) Washing (with water)
- (2) Possibility of chlorine-based bleaching
- (3) Ironing
- (4) Dry-cleaning
- (5) Wringing
- (6) Drying
