# Test methods for colour fastness to rubbing

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### Foreword

This Japanese Industrial Standard has been revised by the Minister of Economy, Trade and Industry through deliberations at the Japanese Industrial Standards Committee as the result of proposal for revision of Japanese Industrial Standard submitted by Suga Weathering Technology Foundation (SWTF)/Japanese Standards Association (JSA) with a draft being attached, based on the provision of Article 12, paragraph (1) of the Industrial Standard ardization Act applied mutatis mutandis pursuant to the provision of Article 16 of the said Act. This edition replaces the previous edition (JIS L 0849 : 2013), which has been technically revised.

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# Test methods for colour fastness to rubbing

#### Introduction

This Japanese Industrial Standard has been prepared based on **ISO 105-X12** : 2016, Edition 6 and **ISO 105-X19** : 2020, Edition 1 with some modifications of the technical contents.

The vertical lines on both sides and dotted underlines indicate changes from the corresponding International Standards. A list of modifications with the explanations is given in Annex JA.

#### 1. Scope

This Standard specifies the test methods for determining the colour fastness of dyed textiles to rubbing.

NOTE The International Standards corresponding to this Standard and the symbol of degree of correspondence are as follows.

ISO 105-X12: 2016 Textiles—Tests for colour fastness—Part X12: Colour fastness to rubbing

ISO 105-X19: 2020 Textiles—Tests for colour fastness—Part X19: Colour fastness to rubbing (Gakushin test method) (overall evaluation: MOD)
