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Foreword

Introduction

This Japanese Industrial Standard has been prepared based on **ISO 13688** : 2013, Edition 2, and Amendment 1 : 2021 with some modifications of the technical contents for the convenience of users. The amendment(s) to the said International Standard(s) has been incorporated into this Standard.

The vertical lines on both sides and dotted underlines indicate changes from the corresponding International Standard. A list of modifications with the explanations is given in Annex JA.

1 Scope

This Standard specifies general performance requirements for ergonomics, innocuousness, size designation, ageing caused by cleaning, compatibility and marking of protective clothing and the information to be supplied by the manufacturer with the protective clothing.

This Standard is only intended to be used in combination with other standards for protective clothing, containing requirements for specific protective performance and not on a stand-alone basis.

NOTE The International Standard corresponding to this Standard and the symbol of degree of correspondence are as follows.
