## Foreword

This translation has been made based on the original Japanese Industrial Standard revised by the Minister of Economy, Trade and Industry through deliberations at the Japanese Industrial Standards Committee, as the result of proposal for revision of Japanese Industrial Standard submitted by Japan Kraft Paper Sacks Industrial Association (JKPSA)/Japanese Standards Association (JSA) with the draft being attached, based on the provision of Article 12 Clause 1 of the Industrial Standardization Law applicable to the case of revision by the provision of Article 14. Consequently **JIS Z 0239**: 1996 is replaced with this Standard.

This revision has been made based on **ISO 8351-1**: 1994 Packaging—Method of specification of sacks—Part 1: Paper sacks for the purposes of making it easier to compare this Standard with International Standard; to prepare Japanese Industrial Standard conforming with International Standard; and to propose a draft of an International Standard which is based on Japanese Industrial Standard.

Attention is drawn to the possibility that some parts of this Standard may conflict with a patent right, application for a patent after opening to the public, utility model right or application for registration of utility model after opening to the public which have technical properties. ## Kraft paper sacks—Method of specification

JIS Z 0239: 2004

**Introduction** This Japanese Industrial Standard has been prepared based on the first edition of **ISO 8351-1**: 1994 *Packaging—Method of specification for sacks—Part 1*: *Paper sacks* published in 1994 with some modifications of the technical contents.

Portions given sidelines or dotted underlines are the matters modified from the original International Standard. The list of modification with the explanation is given in annex 2 (informative)

1 Scope This Standard provides a checklist for the characteristics of kraft paper sacks (hereafter referred to as "paper sacks") to be specified by the parties concerned when ordering.

This Standard is primarily intended for application to the types of paper sacks specified in **JIS Z 0102**.

Remarks: The International Standard corresponding to this Standard is as follows.

In addition, symbols which denote the degree of correspondence in the contents between the relevant International Standard and **JIS** are IDT (identical), MOD (modified), and NEQ (not equivalent) according to **ISO/IEC Guide 21**.

## 3 Method of specification

**3.1** General When drawing up the specifications of a paper sack for ordering purposes, customer and manufacturer shall consider each item in the following lists and, where relevant, mutually agree to include them in the ordering specifications at an appropriate level.
