Sprayable and Strippable Protective Plastic Coatings Z 1708-1976 (Reaffirmed: 1985)

1. Scope

This Japanese Industrial Standard specifies sprayable and strippable protective plastic coatings, hereinafter referred to as the "strippable plastic coatings".

2. <u>Definition</u>

The strippable plastic coatings referred in this standard are the generic name of coatings which form films to protect things from corrosion or mechanical damage and the films of which can be easily stripped when the things are used. There are organic solution type coating consists of solution of plastic into organic solvent, aqueous dispersion type coating consists of emulsification of plastic by water, organosol type coating consists of solution of plastic by organic solvent and aqueous solution type coating consists of solution of plastic into water.

3. Classification

The strippable plastic coatings are classified as shown in Table 1, according to their states, purpose of use and principal application fields.
