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Foreword

This Japanese Industrial Standard has been revised by the Minister of Economy, Trade and Industry through deliberations at the Japanese Industrial Standards Committee as the result of proposal for revision of Japanese Industrial Standard submitted by The Japan Association of Corrosion Control (JACC)/Japanese Standards Association (JSA) with a draft being attached, based on the provision of Article 12, paragraph (1) of the Industrial Standardization Act applied *mutatis mutandis* pursuant to the provision of Article 16 of the said Act. This edition replaces the previous edition (**JIS Z 1902** : 2009), which has been technically revised.

Introduction

This Japanese Industrial Standard was established in 1987, and has gone through three revisions including this one. The previous revision took place in 2009, since which there has been a change in the composition of types of petrolatum tapes products. The main purpose of this revision is to update the specifications to reflect this change.

No corresponding International Standard has been established at this point.

1 Scope

This Standard specifies requirements for petrolatum tapes for corrosion protection (hereafter referred to as tapes) used mainly for protection of steel pipes, steel bars and other iron and steel products from corrosion for an extended period of time.
